They leave behind very distinct fecal pellets called frass. These pellets are hexagonal in shape and are about 1 mm long. Termites push them out of their tunnel, and over time it accumulates. As do termites in any state, termites in Florida look a lot like large ants with wings. There are some subtle differences between termites and flying ants, however. Adult termites are dark brown or black, with straight antennae, long wings of equal length and a straight body, while flying ants can be black, dark brown or reddish in color, with bent antennae, wings that are uneven in length and a thin or pinched waist.

In 2005, Nan-Yao Su, Ph.D., at the University of Florida led a study that introduced a novel experimental setup for examining the behavior of colony-level numbers of Formosan subterranean termite (*Coptotermes formosanus*).This setup was the first to simulate, in the lab, long-distance foraging for tunneling termites, using tubing and planar arenas so that all termites could be observed at all time.

The most common subterranean termites in North America belong to the genus *Reticulitermes*. The Eastern subterranean termite, *R. flavipes*, and the Western subterranean termite, *R. virginicus*, are found in Florida.They are not as aggressive as *C. formosanus* or *C. gestroi*, but are nonetheless significant pests in Florida.Like other subterranean termites, they nest in the soil and form mud tubes ...

Florida is relatively rich in termite species diversity compared to the rest of mainland U.S. Twenty-one termite species were recorded in Florida and among them at least six established were invasive species (more than any other states), mostly due to the sub-tropical climate of Florida and high human activity.

When Do Termites Swarm in Florida? Because Florida is warm and humid, different termite species swarm throughout the year. The swarming habits of the most common species in Florida are described below. The eastern subterranean termite swarms in daylight between October and February. (In other states, this species swarms from February to May.)
