This book (Complete Book of Fly Tying, Second Edition - Hardcopy) combined with Leiser's The Book of Fly Patterns makes a complete reference set for beginning and experienced fly tyers, alike. I bought Leiser's Pattern book first (in the Kindle version) and while looking for a little more individual tying instruction guidance decided to purchase this volume as an addition.

Originally published in 1980, this book quickly became recognized as a 'must-read' for any would-be bridge expert, and has never been out of print. Now, almost 30 years later, the author has revised, updated and expanded it to take into account modern developments in the theory and practice of competitive bidding.
